Entries must be in place by 9:00 a.m. on June 29, 2017.

1. A recipe may not be divided and two or more entries made in one or more classes at the same time. In other words, two people may not exhibit entries made from the same batch or when a cake is divided, two people may not exhibit each separate half.
2. Only exhibits which are products of the "home kitchen" will be eligible. NO PREPARED MIXES.
3. Great care must be taken to make the exhibit attractive, for exhibits are first judged by appearance.
4. Cake exhibits must be placed on cardboard and cardboard should be covered with white paper. The cardboard should be the size of the cake for ease of display.
5. Cookies, candies, and bread should be displayed on paper plates to correspond with the size of the entry. NO GLASS PLATES. The fair cannot be responsible for china, glass, or tin plates
6. Any entry not placing, is to be picked up after 5:00 p.m. , June 29, 2017, will be discarded.

1. Must have new 2-piece metal lids.
2. One jar per item listed.
3. If judges deem it necessary to facilitate their judging, jars that first pass the appearance test will be opened for flavor.
4. All exhibits in this department must be canned from fresh fruit and vegetables and must not be re-canned from commercially canned foods.
5. Exhibits must be in pint or quart jars or jelly jars where applicable. Exhibits must be labeled as to variety or kind and date of canning, regardless of the year canned. Labels should be suitable, uniform, neat, and placed from ½ to 1 inch from the bottom of the jar
